

Baby's Debut Important Diagnostic Ultrasound Reminders

Please read the following information for important reminders on how to schedule a diagnostic appointment, requirements and reminders before your ultrasound session, and more.

SCHEDULING AN APPOINTMENT

- All diagnostic appointments must be scheduled over the phone; we do not currently offer online booking for these types of appointments.
- We must receive a referral from your physician/midwife BEFORE scheduling an appointment.
 - Referrals can be sent to <u>Babys.debut.ny@gmail.com</u>
- Be advised that a valid credit or debit card will be required to hold your appointment.
 - Your card will be verified 3-4 days prior to your appointment; if we receive an error or decline for any reason, we will reach out to you to collect a \$35 deposit to continue to hold your appointment. If for any reason we are unable to reach you, your appointment could be canceled.
- Baby's Debut has a 24-hour reschedule or cancelation policy to avoid a \$35 fee being charged to your card on file.
 - No-shows will result in a \$35 fee being charged to your card on file and a potential ban from scheduling an appointment unless a \$35 deposit is paid at booking.

GENERAL REMINDERS

- Payment will be due <u>in full</u> at check-in on the day of your appointment.
 - We do not currently accept any form of Health Insurance; however, we do accept HSA cards.
 - All major credit/debit cards are accepted, as well as cash; personal checks are NOT accepted.
 - Be advised, a \$5 processing fee applies for all credit/debit card transactions at the office.
- A \$75 fee applies for each additional baby.
- We recommend that you hydrate well before receiving an ultrasound, by drinking at least 20-30 ounces of water about 1 hour prior to your appointment.
 - o Do not empty your bladder immediately prior to your appointment.
- All diagnostic scans include two complimentary printed images of baby;
 - Diagnostic clients looking to add-on things such as Heartbeat Animals, or 3D/4D images will
 have to schedule the respective appointment on a different date or time than their diagnostic
 exam.
- All exams will be read by a Board-Certified Radiologist, and a report will be sent to your physician/midwife.
 - Be advised that ultrasonographers cannot make a medical diagnosis. Your physician/midwife (once they have received your ultrasound report) will notify you of any concerns or general information as a result of your ultrasound with us.
